KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Myra Martz Huth, PhD, RN, FAAN received her PhD from Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, OH. Her MSN was earned at Marquette University and BSN from Alverno College. Dr. Huth conducts research to reduce children’s pain and has had several funded studies. During the past 35 years she has been an assistant vice president, research associate, nurse educator, clinical nurse specialist, school nurse, and staff nurse in the pediatric and neonatal arenas. Dr. Huth is currently a consultant for evidence-based practice and research. Her publications include topics related to nursing interventions to reduce children’s postoperative pain, a theory of pain management, instrumentation, and pediatric clinical practice. She is also a board member and reviews manuscripts for pediatric nursing journals. Dr. Huth is President-Elect for the Society of Pediatric Nurses.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this conference is to define evidence-based practice and identify strategies that facilitate utilization of evidence/best practices and to describe current evidence and best practices in select areas of pediatric care.

OBJECTIVES

- Identify evidence-based practice (EBP) and nursing research and the steps needed to process such.
- Discuss current evidence-based practice projects and the processes used.
- Describe the pediatric obesity epidemic and successful treatment strategies.
