

**KOHL'S****Trauma Related Injury Prevention**

at the Children's Hospital of Michigan

The Kohl's Trauma Related Injury Prevention (TRIP) program curriculum is divided into learning-level modules designed to involve children as active participants. Schools/organizations can tailor the program to meet their specific needs. Topics are chosen from a menu format; from one to all of the topics. Specific topics can be taught to particular grades. The Kohl's TRIP program uses local safety professionals to teach the topics, and encourages the teachers to reiterate and reinforce the lessons, which makes the program most effective. The Kohl's TRIP program targets the following leading causes of injuries of children:

GRADES	TOPICS	OBJECTIVES
(Pre-K – 2 <sup>nd</sup> grades)	Choking, Suffocation, & Strangulation Prevention	Students learn the importance of breathing, and how to prevent related injuries.
(Pre-K – 2 <sup>nd</sup> grades)	Poisoning Prevention	Students learn what a poison is and how to avoid getting poisoned.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Motor Vehicle & Bus Safety	Students learn the importance of wearing a seatbelt and how to be a safe bus passenger.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Fire and Burn Safety	Students learn how to prevent a fire, how to escape a burning home, and what to do if they catch on fire.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Falls Prevention & Accessing 911	Students learn to play safely, and how to call 911.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Bike & Pedestrian Safety *	Students learn safe street crossing and the importance of wearing a helmet when on their bike, roller blades, skateboard, skates, or scooter.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Water Safety	Students learn to always wear a floatation device and never swim alone.
(Pre-K – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Personal Safety	Students learn “stranger danger” and internet safety.
(3 <sup>rd</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Gun Safety	Students learn to leave the area immediately if they see a gun and tell a grownup.
(3 <sup>rd</sup> – 6 <sup>th</sup> grades)	Home Safety Jeopardy	Students answer questions in a game format regarding safety issues while being home, staying safe and getting help when needed

\* Bike Safety & Pedestrian Safety can be taught separately.
